OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
At 1-level: 7+ with good suit
At 2-level: sound (10+ with 6 cards, (11)/12+ with 5 cards
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-18 hcp; 10-14 hcp in reopening position
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Preemptive (5-11)
[1 any] 2NT = 2 lower suits
Reopen: 2NT = nat. 18-19, new suit = 6+ cards, 12-15
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
2-suiter (see above)
[1x] 3x = asks for stopper
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
2♣ = majors, at least 4-4 ▶ 2NT = nat. invit. 3M = invit.
X = penalty
2♦/2♥/2♠ = natural
VS. PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
T/O double thru 4♥
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
Strong 1♣: DBL. = majors, 1NT = minors, suit = natural
Strong 2♣: natural, jumps are weak, DBL shows good ♣
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Rdbl = strong, 1M [X] XX followed by 3M = 3-cards, 10-12
new suit at 1-level = forcing
New suit at 2-level = non forcing

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
5-card majors, ,
Response of 1NT to all opening bids = non forcing (6-10)
Strong jump shifts (1♣ - 2 M, 1 M - 3x)
1NT 15-15 hcp, 2♣ asks for major (7+ points)
2♣ = GF, response, 2♦ = neg.
2♦ opening = 20-21 hcp, balanced, 2 NT = 22-23 hcp
2♥ / ♠ = 6+ -card suit, 5-10 hcp
