Reop: 1t;o dbl
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd : 15-18 on min op: Stayman, Transfer
On Maj op : Transfer
4 th 10 -13 (14) same
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak2 even 1 ♣ 2 ♦
2NT = 2 lowest suits

DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
1 ♣ 2 ♣ Maj ; 1 ♦ 2 ♦ Maj; 1 ♥ 2 ♥ = ♠ ♣ ; 1 ♠ 2 ♠ = ♥ ♣
1Y- 1Z 2Y shows 2 others suits, 2Z nat,2NT minors
Jump cuebids ask for NT
Reop: cuebid shows 2 suits
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
Vs Strong: X 5min4Maj 3 1(min) / 2NT = 2minors suits
2 ♦ : one Major suit / 2 ♥ / ♠ : nat with a minor
Reop : X is good Landy/ 2 ♣ = Landy may be weak
2 ♦ / ♥ / ♠ / nat suit
Vs weak : X is at least good opening values
Other same like strong NT
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
2Maj X – 2NT is 8-9 and more any hand
2Maj 3Maj is 2 min. suits / 4 ♣ / ♦ is nat with other Maj
2 ♦ Multi 4 ♣ / ♦ is nat with ♥
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
Transfer on min opening and reverse Truscott
Truscott on Maj op., 1 ♥ X 2 ♦ *good fit; 1 ♠ X 2 ♥ *good fit
