## FIREWORKS AT THE START

Marek Wójcicki

Poland and Lithuania are two countries with strong historic connections - from 1569 till 1795 they were in the union known as Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth. Now they are separate countries, but some connections, and particularly friendship, still exist.

At our event we have four teams from Poland and one from Lithuania. But when you check the players of Lithuania team at this tournament, you will see many Polish names. Thus it should not be a surprise that the line up at Table 1 match of Round 1 (LITHUANIA and POLAND MARKOWICZ are two top seeded teams of the tournament) was all-Polish: Kowalski - Romański vs Markowicz - Moszczyński and Olański - Russyan vs Blat - Bizoń.

Great Dealer prepared some spectacular hands for the first day of the tournament and we had some real fireworks also in the Lithuania - Poland match..

### EXCLUSION BLACKWOOD

You are sitting North (white vs red) with:

♠ AKQ65 ♥ AKJ643 ♦ – ♣ Q10

First surprise – partner opens 1NT! You decided to start with transfer to hearts 2♦. Next surprise – partner bids 3♥. According to the system, it is not the maximum of the strength, but 4-card support.

Now it is easy – you have a useful toy in the system – Exclusion Blackwood (Voidwood). You bid 5♦ and partner's 5♠ bid shows 1 keycard outside clubs. It should be enough for grand, so you bid 7♥.

It was of course the flat board. The Polish pair started with the 1♥ opening, but they used the same convention and for them also three rounds of bidding were enough:

### LIGHTNER DOUBLE

Once again you are sitting North (white vs red). This time you held:

♠ AJ632 ♥ J10532 ♦ A75 ♣ –

LHO opens 1♥, partner passes, RHO bids 2♣ (Polish style – GF, natural or balanced hand). You pass, LHO shows another suit – 2♦, partner passes, RHO raises to 3♦, you are still waiting, LHO bids 3♥, RHO 4♣ and dealer concludes with 5♦. After two passes it is your bid. You would like partner to lead a club – ruff and two aces should be enough to set the contract, so you make lead directing double. All pass:

South led ♣8. Declarer erred, playing the ace from dummy. North ruffed, cashed ace of trumps and continued with another trump. He had to get two more tricks. 500 for Lithuania.

At the replay East-West got a chance for a telephone number score. South found his hand worth club preempt after 1♥ opening. It was not easy to re-open with the double – East bid 3♦ and West bid 3NT:

### DOUBLE-EDGED SWORD

Light openings do not always favor their fans. Look at the example:

This time you are sitting East. Once again white vs red. This time you held:

♠ 3 ♥ AQ74 ♦ 1043 ♣ A9865

Playing Polish Club with 2♣ Precision opening, you find this hand worth opening, or not?

Moszczyński opened 2♣.

At replay Olański did not open.

South started with 1♦, North bid 1♠ (East - West were silent), South showed second suit – 2♣. Now North made an invitational jump to 3♠ and South with minimum and spade singleton, rejected an invitation.
