## Useful Space Principle = USP

USP is used by 4. hand after 2. hands overcall provided that:
-The opening is 1 . Level
-The overcall is without jump
-Third hand bids Pass, 1NT or DBL negative

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A bid by 4. hand shows the next suit (transfer) except if it is the only way for a natural bid.
Example: 1v2*PASS 2v = A suit
\(2 \boldsymbol{A}=\%\) suit
\(3 \%=\) Support - good hand
\(3 \star=\) Support - less than the \(3 \&\) bid.
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Exception: After $(1 *) 2 \&$ overcall, $2 *$ asks for Major 4-card suit
USP is also used by a passed hand
